FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Is the "Hold Deposit" separate from the "Registration Fee?"

Yes. The registration fee includes entrance fees to Mr. Grand Jeremy's private on-board events and processing fees, while your hold deposit holds your cabin and is deducted from your total cruise price.

2. Is there a payment plan available?

Yes. Contact www.uplift.com where you obtain ways to finance your travel including airfare, cruise fare, hotel stays, excursions and tours. However, you can also split your payments into two payments as long as the balance is paid in full by **November 5, 2021**.

3. Do I need a passport?

Yes. A valid passport is required to sail on Princess Cruise on this Caribbean itinerary; and your name should appear exactly as shown on your travel document.

4. Do I need to be vaccinated against Covid-19 before I can board the ship?

Yes, as of this writing. Guests are required to have received their final dose of an approved COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days prior to the beginning of the cruise and show proof of vaccination to board the ship. Vaccinated guests may participate in Princess operated tours and independent sightseeing. It will be necessary to follow the health protocols for every port we visit, which are under the control of local government and subject to change without prior notice. Guests must come prepared to follow local guidance pertaining to mask wearing, physical distancing, testing/health screenings, etc.

5. Do I need to be tested for Covid-19 prior to boarding the ship?

Yes, Princess Cruises requires that ALL guests to produce a negative COVID-19 test (PCR or antigen) taken within 3 days of their embarkation on all Princess sailings.

6. Is the crew & employees on-board the ship vaccinated against Covid-19?

Yes. All crew on-board the ship have been vaccinated

7. Is there a mask wearing requirement?

Yes. Guests are strongly encouraged to wear face masks when in public spaces indoors. ALL guests will be required to wear a face mask, with no exceptions, in elevators and in designated indoor entertainment areas, all retail shops, and in the casino except when eating or drinking.

8. Will I get seasick?

While we cannot guarantee it, seasickness is rarely a problem due to the large size of today's modern cruise ships. However, if you're more sensitive to motion sickness on cruises, stay prepared with store-bought solutions. Some of the most popular products include skin patches and wristbands or Dramamine or Bonine tablets. Also let us know, and we will try to select a cabin that is more in the center of the ship to help reduce the chances of seasickness.

9. Are all my meals & drinks free on-board the ship?

Yes, most, if not all, your meals are FREE and included in your fare (with the exception of the 5-star specialty restaurants which have an additional surcharge). This includes everything from regional cuisine connected to the local culture, comfort food like the best pizza at sea and 24-hour free room service. Drinks are normally not free however, we have secured a Princess Premium Drink package to be included in your fare. This includes cocktails, wine, beer, spirits, fountain soda, specialty coffees, bottled water, teas and other individual beverages up to \$12 each. [This package normally costs \$59.99 per day, per person]

10. Is there wifi on the ship?

Yes. We have selected the Princess Plus premium package for you which includes FREE wifi in your fare. Princess' *MedallionNet* Wi-Fi offers the best internet at sea allowing you to text, post photos, video chat and stream your favorite shows, movies, music and sports.

11. What should I wear to dinner on the ship?

It depends. Usually, you dress the same way you would do for a visit to a restaurant at home. Skirts, dresses or trousers with t-shirt or blouse for ladies, trousers and shirt or poloshirt for gentlemen. Shoes are always required in dining venues, regardless of the time of day, and robes, shorts and bathing suits are not allowed in any of the restaurants. (Be sure to take a cover-up or a t-shirt and shorts with you if you're planning to spend your day near the pool). However, if there is a formal night, evening gown, cocktail dress or pantsuits for ladies, suit, combination or dinner jackets for men.

12. Do I need to bring extra money on the cruise?

You should bring your extra cash or your credit/debit card (which the number is kept on file) to be used for any onboard purchases, spa services, additional drinks, meals in 5-star formal restaurants, purchases during the land excursions, etc. At the end of the cruise you will be given an itemized receipt of all your credit card/debit charges.

13. Can I smoke on-board the ship?

Princess Cruises prohibits smoking or vaping of all types, including e-cigarettes, in guest staterooms and balconies. Violators will face a \$250 fine for each occurrence, which will be charged to the guest's stateroom account. However, there are clearly marked "Designated Smoking Areas" are available on-board and include a sufficient number of ashtrays that are emptied regularly.

14. Can I bring medical marijuana or CBD on-board the ship?

No, marijuana of any type (including both medical and recreational) is not allowed on cruise ships, even if the ships sails from a state where the drug is legal. This rule includes items like CBD oils as well. Remember that on a cruise, it's not just a matter of United States' law. Ships sail from port to port, putting passengers under the laws of several different countries in the course of a single cruise

15. What else is there to do on a cruise ship?

There is just about every music genre you can think of (rock, pop, soul, jazz, reggae) along with Broadway type shows, magicians, comedians, and a host of other entertainment.
